What does the human rights code say?

FN:UN Universal Declaration *Articles 3 and 5*

- Everyone has the right to life, liberty and personal security.
- No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.

CEDAW - Convention on the Elimination of Discrimination and All Forms of Violence against Women

Convention on the Rights of the Child *Article 19*

- The child has the right to be protected from physical or mental violence and from neglect or exploitation by parents or other carers.

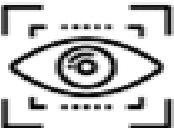

How does violence in close relationships differ between the genders?

Violence against men

- More often victims of psychological than physical violence
- Difficult to identify as a victim of violence (macho culture).
- Fear of not being believed/being accused
- Average number of victims of fatal violence in a relationship: 2 persons per year (BRÅ 2017-2023)



Violence against women

- Violence is generally more severe
- More repeated
- More sexualised
- With more controlling elements
- Average number of victims of fatal violence in a relationship: 14 people per year (BRÅ 2017-2023)
